May's Drive-in Movies in Beacon Park

'Blow the doors off' and 'have the time of your life' at two Drive-in Movies at Beacon Park this May!

After the success of Grease, our first Drive-in Movie at Beacon Park that took place last summer, we're offering two films in May and two more in August. We'll be improving the way we marshal cars in and will open the gates earlier.

The Italian Job (1969) on Saturday 12 May. Rated a PG, the film stars Michael Caine who plays a former prisoner who is planning a 'big job' to steal gold bars in Italy with the help of a criminal gang, mini cars and traffic chaos.

Dirty Dancing on Saturday 19 May. Rated a 15, Dirty Dancing follows 'Baby' Houseman (Jennifer Grey) as she goes on a journey of self-discovery with the help of dancer Johnny, played by Patrick Swayze.

The films will play on a giant inflatable screen, and movie-goers simply need to tune their car radios in to hear the soundtrack. There will be a reserved area in front of the cars for on foot ticket holders, and movie meals and cinema snacks will be on offer as well as some extra surprises.

Gates will open at 12noon to allow audience members to park up and enjoy all that Beacon Park and Lichfield has to offer. Both films will then start at around 9.15pm.

We will also be screening a further two drive-in movies later in the summer, Top Gun on **Friday 10 August** and Pretty Woman on **Saturday 11 August**.

It costs £25 a movie per car (max 4 people) and £5 on foot (optional £3 headset hire & £15 deposit). Tickets must be booked in advance, available at Lichfield Garrick Box Office by calling **01543 412121** and online at **www.lichfieldgarrick.com.**

Peace Woodland for Beacon Park

We're working with Lichfield Cathedral on their Great Exhibition, Imagine Peace, that will feature 1,918 trees in an art installation by Artist in Residence, Peter Walker. Running from 17 to 27 August, the exhibition will explore the themes of war, reconciliation and peace.

The trees will then be planted in Beacon Park (by the poppy field next to the golf course) creating a new Peace Woodland. Planting will start in November and the new woodland will be launched in April 2019.

So far our parks team, along with volunteers, have potted hundreds of trees. In February the Dean of Lichfield, The Very Revd Adrian Dorber came to our Community Garden to take a look at the progress so far and helped to pot a tree.

He said: "2018 marks 100 years since the guns of World War One fell silent. Those who survived hoped it would be the war to end all wars, but the last century has seen millions more suffer in conflict all around the world. We must never forget the sacrifices made in war - we must also always continue to strive for peace."

Dedicate your name to peace

At the heart of the woodland will be a bronze plaque as a dedication for peace. For £25 you can add a name - your own or a family member - to be permanently inscribed in the name of peace. Find out how at www.lichfield-cathedral.org/peace.
