





Twig hunt and keep warm trail

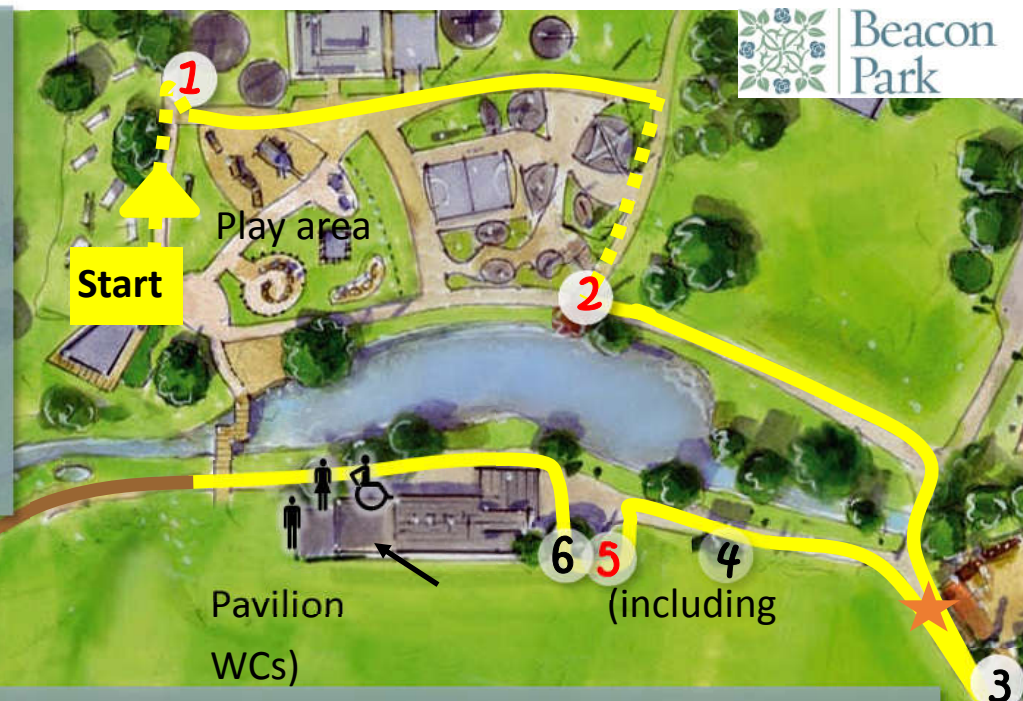
for wheelchair users

Accessibility key:

-  Tarmac surface
-  stone path (well compacted)
-  Slight gradients
-  Steeper but short gradient

What to do:

Use the map and directions to find the 12 trees in the order given. They are marked with a light blue 'splodge' to help you spot them.

- Trees with a **red number (1,2,5,7 & 9)** are your *learning trees*. The information and photographs will give you clues on how to identify the twigs on that particular type of tree.
- Trees with a **black number** are your *test yourself trees*. These trees are one of the species you will have already met on the trail. Can you tell what type of tree it is? Answers on back page.

This trail will help you identify five different types of trees from just their winter twigs! There's also some fun, physical challenges to help keep you warm along the way...
